


## Rare Disease Day

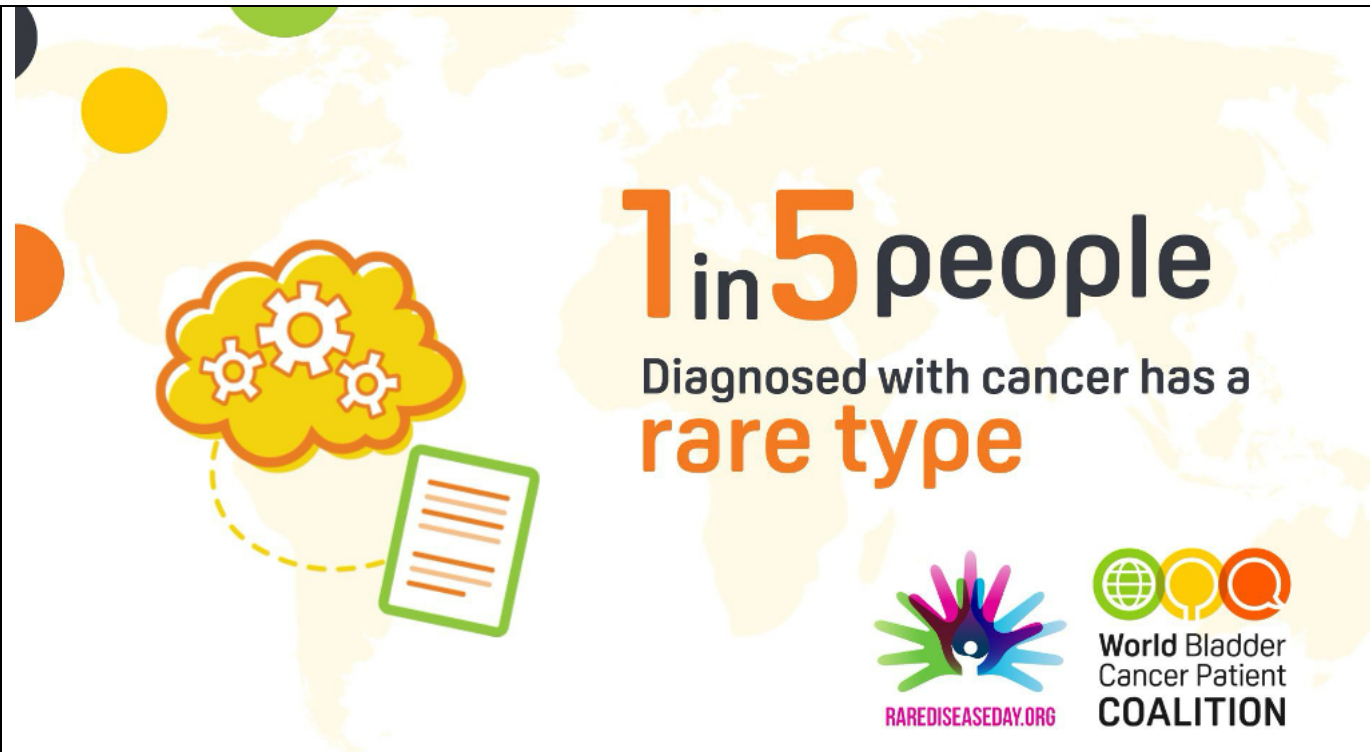
Today is #RareDiseaseDay!
